REQUIREMENTS FOR INSIDE PLANT SALE VENDORS:

I/our organization is an indoor plant sale vendor and have read and agree to the protocols listed below: _____ (Signature)

1. ALL PLANTS SOLD MUST BE FLORIDA NATIVES.

2. PLANT LABELS: Each plant sold must have the name displayed and a price tag which includes sales tax.

3. PLANT LIST SUBMITTAL: Send the list of plants you will sell with your application form. We entice customers by providing a list of plants available. Any plant not listed or approved by FNPS in writing 30 days before the sale cannot be sold. FNPS reserves the right to remove plants from the sale. Please return the form as soon as possible so we can include this information in the publicity flyer. In addition, a banner will be on display at the entrance to the event to publicize the event to the general public.

4. NOT PERMITTED: Bare-root, less-than-established potted plants, and cultivars which are not on the Association of Florida Native Nurseries (AFNN) list. We have adopted the AFNN policy regarding cultivars, allowing only for the use of cultivars that originate within the eco-regions that naturally occur in Florida. Please consult that policy, available at the AFNN website: www.afnn.org

5. NOT SURE IF IT IS A FLORIDA NATIVE PLANT? If you have a plant that you believe to be a Florida native, but which does not appear to meet the guidelines, please contact Dan Miller (contact information below). Please provide the full scientific name, cultivar name any, and origin of the plant.

6. LOCAL PREFERENCE: All eco-regional plants are welcome, but keep in mind many attendees will be coming from the Panhandle and North Florida regions. We encourage vendors to highlight and identify plants grown locally and to identify those plants particularly well suited to North Florida based on origins and natural habitat. Special signage and labeling will help sell your plants.
