**1. ALL PLANTS SOLD MUST BE FLORIDA NATIVES.**

**2. PLANT LABELS:** Each plant sold must have the name displayed.

**3. PLANT LIST SUBMITTAL:** Please send a list of plants that you will most likely be selling at the conference. We will entice potential customers by providing a list of plants that will be available. FNPS will also provide large information sheets and signs (see attached sample) to help promote your sales. FNPS reserves the right to remove plants from the sale if they are found to be non-native to Florida or cultivars that do not originate within Florida's ecoregions.

**4. NOT PERMITTED:** Bare-root, less-than-established potted plants, and cultivars which do not naturally occur in Florida ecoregions. FNPS has adopted the AFNN policy regarding cultivars, allowing for the use of cultivars that originate within the eco-regions that naturally occur in Florida. **6. LOCAL PREFERENCE:** All eco-regional plants are welcome, but keep in mind that many attendees will be coming from other regions of Florida. Special signage and labeling will help sell your plants.

**7. FEES:** No fees will be charged for you to sell/vend at the conference. FNPS is inviting you so that we can promote Florida's native plant nurseries and Florida native plants for landscaping and restoration.

**8. SET UP:** Set up on Thursday, May 17<sup>th</sup> from 8:00 am until 5:00 pm. Sales start at 8:00 am on Friday and Saturday.

**9. BREAK DOWN:** Saturday after the last session at 4:30 pm.
